

Loan and grant for summer 2022 for applicants with reduced functional ability

Who is entitled to receive loan and grant for the summer?

The application applies to applicants who, due to reduced functional ability, are unable to take on salaried employment during the summer holiday (16.06.2022–15.08.2022), but who are able to study and prepare themselves for the next semester. Salaried employment means all employment where the salary is taxable. This also applies to applicants who earn less than the limit for an exemption card. **Exception:** Applicants who hold honorary positions while they are studying are entitled to loan and grant for the summer regardless of whether they receive taxable fees or salaries from the position. The scheme also applies to applicants who because of physical disability require necessary modifications in the workplace, and thus have difficulties securing a summer job. It is sufficient that one of these conditions applies to the applicant.

A doctor, specialist or other professional with particular knowledge of the reduced functional ability is required to confirm the application details. An assessment of the applicant's functional ability and how that may affect his/her ability to work during the summer 2022 must be performed. A condition for receiving a grant and loan during the summer is that the applicant has been attending a course during the spring semester of 2022 and will continue studying in autumn 2022.

Process and application deadline

You must complete the form in collaboration with a doctor/specialist and submit it by post to Lånekassen, postboks 450 Alnabru, 0614 Oslo. Lånekassen must receive the form before the deadline 15. August 2022. Remember that both you and your doctor must sign this form. The doctor should sign in item 4, and you should sign in item 5 at the bottom of page 2.

Additional grant during the academic year and grant for delay

You can also apply for an additional grant during the academic year or grant for delay beyond one academic year / 60 credits.
